complaint, *in rem* in the above-captioned action. The CAFRA deadline for the Government to file its complaint is currently January 21, 2014.

For its grounds, the United States says that the undersigned Assistant United States Attorney assigned to this case is still evaluating the case to determine the viability of filing a civil action. The undersigned has not had sufficient time to consult with the case agent on this case, because he (the case agent) has been outside of the country. The undersigned also intends to consult with lawyers and experts to assess the viability of a civil action.

The undersigned has discussed this matter with Claimant's counsel, George Crow, and he has given Government counsel consent to inform this Court that he does not have an objection to this continuance.

WHEREFORE, the United States moves this Court to grant its motion to extend the time for the United States to file its reply brief in this matter for an additional thirty (30) days; or until February 21, 2014.
