(Docket No. 55)

Currently pending before the Court is Plaintiff’s “motion attacking sentence.” Docket No. 55.¹ Plaintiff indicates that he is “motioning to attack the sentence to the FISA probe,” *id.* at 1, and then provides roughly ten pages of rambling about his mental health issues and Defendant’s purported mind-control operation, interspersed with citation to various rules, statutes and orders, *see id.* at 1-11. The Court is unable to discern the relief sought at this time by Plaintiff through this motion. Accordingly, the motion is hereby DENIED without prejudice.
