(ECF No. 3.) A party may file specific written objections to the 11 findings and recommendations of a United States Magistrate Judge made pursuant to Local 12 Rule IB 1-4. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B); D. Nev. R. IB 3-2. Upon the filing of such objections, 13 the Court must make a de novo determination of those portions to which objections are made. 14 Id. The Court may accept, reject, or modify, in whole or in part, the findings or 15 recommendations made by the Magistrate Judge. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); D. Nev. IB 3-2(b). 16 Here, no objections were filed, and the deadline to do so has expired.
