Lifting Stay 7 Robert LeGrand, et al., [ECF No. 29] 8 Respondents 9 10 On August 8, 2016, I stayed this action pending exhaustion of Perkins's due-process claim in Nevada state court, and I instructed Perkins to move to reopen this case at the conclusion of his state-11 12 court proceedings.<sup>1</sup> Perkins now moves to reopen this case.<sup>2</sup> Respondents have filed a nonopposition, reserving any potential defenses.<sup>3</sup> 13 14 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Perkins's motion to reopen [ECF No. 29] is 15 **GRANTED.** The Clerk of Court is directed to reopen this action and LIFT the stay. 16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the supplemental exhibits [ECF No. 30] will be considered as additional exhibits to Perkins's first amended petition [ECF No. 14]. 17 18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondents must answer or otherwise respond to the first 19 amended petition [ECF No. 14] by February 19, 2017. If respondents file and serve an answer, it 20 must comply with Rule 5 of the Rules Governing Section 2254 cases in the United States District 21 Courts.
