15	Petitioner has submitted an application to proceed in forma pauperis (Dkt. #1) and a petition	
16	for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. The court finds that petitioner is unable	
17	to pay the filing fee.	
18	Petitioner has submitted a motion for appointment of counsel (Dkt. #2). Petitioner is unable	
19	to afford counsel, and the issues presented warrant the appointment of counsel. See 18 U.S.C.	
20	§ 3006A(a)(2)(B).	
21	<b>IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED</b> that the application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> (Dkt.	
22	#1) is <b>GRANTED</b> . Petitioner need not pay the filing fee of five dollars (\$5.00).	
23	<b>IT IS FURTHER ORDERED</b> that the clerk of the court shall file the petition for a writ of	
24	habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.	
25	<b>IT IS FURTHER ORDERED</b> that petitioner's motion for appointment of counsel (Dkt.	
26	#2) is <b>GRANTED</b> . The Federal Public Defender is provisionally appointed to represent petitioner.	
27	<b>IT IS FURTHER ORDERED</b> that the Federal Public Defender shall have thirty (30) days	
28	1 Irom the date that this order is entered to und	lertake direct representation of petitioner or to indicate

to the court his inability to represent petitioner in these proceedings. If the Federal Public Defender
 does undertake representation of petitioner, he shall then have sixty (60) days to file an amended
 petition for a writ of habeas corpus. If the Federal Public Defender is unable to represent petitioner,
 then the court shall appoint alternate counsel.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that neither the foregoing deadline nor any extension thereof
6 signifies or will signify any implied finding of a basis for tolling during the time period established.
7 Petitioner at all times remains responsible for calculating the running of the federal limitation
8 period and timely asserting claims.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk shall add Catherine Cortez Masto, Attorney
10 General for the State of Nevada, as counsel for respondents.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk shall electronically serve both the Attorney
12 General of the State of Nevada and the Federal Public Defender a copy of the petition and a copy of
13 this order.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondents' counsel shall enter a notice of appearance
15 within twenty (20) days of entry of this order, but no further response shall be required from
16 respondents until further order of the court.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any exhibits filed by the parties shall be filed with a
18 separate index of exhibits identifying the exhibits by number or letter. The CM/ECF attachments
19 that are filed further shall be identified by the number or numbers (or letter or letters) of the exhibits
20 in the attachment. The hard copy of any additional state court record exhibits shall be
21 forwarded—for this case—to the staff attorneys in Las Vegas.
