Pending before the Court is Plaintiffs’ motion to compel and for sanctions. Docket No. 182. Defendants filed a response in opposition, and Plaintiffs filed a reply. Docket Nos. 199, 206. United States District Judge Richard F. Boulware, II held a hearing on various motions on June 23, 2017. It appears that some of the issues addressed at that hearing may bear on the instant motion. *E.g.*, Docket No. 199 at 2 (stating that issues regarding cancelled checks and bank information are pending review by the assigned district judge). Given that the landscape underlying this motion may have shifted since the motion was filed, it is hereby **DENIED** without prejudice.

Because the Court is denying without prejudice the underlying motion to compel and for sanctions, Defendants’ motion for leave to file a sur-reply at Docket No. 212 is hereby **DENIED** as moot.
