(*Id.* at 9.) Judge Hoffman thus recommends that I deny plaintiff Carlos 16 McDaniel's motion to reverse or remand and grant the defendant's cross-motion to affirm. (*Id.*) 17 McDaniel did not object to Judge Hoffman's Report and Recommendation. Nevertheless, I have 18 reviewed the administrative record de novo, and I accept Judge Hoffman's recommendations. 19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Report and Recommendation (Dkt. #24) is 20 ACCEPTED. 21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff Carlos McDaniel's motion to reverse or 22 remand (Dkt. #19) is DENIED. 23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant Carolyn W.
