



1 The court's Criminal Justice Act designee has located counsel willing to be  
2 appointed to represent the petitioner herein:

7 Finally, Willing filed four *pro se* motions while he was represented by the FPD.  
8 These are fugitive documents that are not properly before the court, and they shall be  
9 denied.

10 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the motion to temporarily lift stay (ECF No.  
11 61) is **GRANTED** for the purposes of this order only.

12 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the motion to withdraw as attorney (ECF No. 62)  
13 is **GRANTED**. The Federal Public Defender is **released as counsel**.

14 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Mary Lou Wilson is **APPOINTED** to represent the  
15 petitioner herein. Ms. Wilson is a Criminal Justice Act panel attorney for the United States  
16 District Court, District of Nevada. Ms. Wilson shall represent petitioner in all future  
17 proceedings in this court relating to this matter (including subsequent actions) and  
18 appeals therefrom, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A (a)(2)(B), until allowed to withdraw.

19 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that CJA counsel Mary Lou Wilson shall enter a notice  
20 of appearance within **twenty (20) days** of the date of this order.

21 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that petitioner's four *pro se* motions: motion for  
22 complete discovery (ECF No. 64); motion for hearing on Senate Bill #182 (ECF No. 65);  
23 motion for appointment of counsel (ECF No. 68); and motion for hearing on newly  
24 discovered evidence (ECF No. 70) are all **DENIED**.
