13	I. DISCUSSION
14	Plaintiff, who is a prisoner in the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons, has
15	submitted a civil rights complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. (ECF No. 1). Plaintiff has
16	neither paid the full filing fee for this matter nor filed an application to proceed in forma
17	pauperis.
18	Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2) and Local Rule LSR 1-2, Plaintiff must complete an
19	application to proceed in forma pauperis and attach both an inmate account statement for the
20	past six months and a properly executed financial certificate. The Court will retain Plaintiff's
21	civil rights complaint (ECF No. 1), but will not file it until the matter of the payment of the filing
22	fee is resolved. Plaintiff will be granted an opportunity to file an application to proceed in forma
23	pauperis, or in the alternative, pay the full filing fee for this action. If Plaintiff chooses to file
24	an application to proceed in forma pauperis he must file a fully complete application to proceed
25	in forma pauperis.
26	II. CONCLUSION
27	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court SHALL SEND
28	Plaintiff the approved form application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> by a prisoner, as well as
	the document entitled information and instructions for filing an in forma nauneris application

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within **thirty (30) days** from the date of this order, Plaintiff shall either: (1) file a fully complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis*, on the correct form with complete financial attachments in compliance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a); or (2) pay the full \$400 fee for filing a civil action (which includes the \$350 filing fee and the \$50 administrative fee).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Plaintiff does not timely comply with this order, dismissal of this action may result.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall retain the complaint (ECF No. 1), but shall not file it at this time.
