In particular, Plaintiff seeks to correct the complaint such that references to "Isidro Baca" are changed to "James Baca" and that references to "B. Donae" are changed to "Bill Donat." See id. at 2. 18 19 Defendants do not oppose that aspect of the pending motion. Docket No. 20 at 2. Accordingly, the 20 motion to correct is hereby **GRANTED**. Pursuant to Local Rule 15-1(a), no later than August 10, 2015, 21 Plaintiff shall file a second amended complaint correcting those two names but otherwise making no 22 additional changes. 23 Plaintiff also requests that the Attorney General's Office accept service on behalf of Defendants 24 Baca and Donat. See Docket No. 17 at 2. Defendants assert that it is not possible for them to accept 25 service because neither Defendants Baca nor Donat are currently employed with the Nevada Department 26 of Corrections. See Docket No. 20 at 2. Accordingly, Plaintiff's request that the Attorney General's Office accept service is hereby **DENIED**. No later than July 27, 2015, the Attorney General's Office 27 28 shall file, under seal and without serving Plaintiff, the last known addresses of Defendants Baca and
