14	On August 13, 2014, Plaintiff, a prisoner in the custody of the Nevada Department of

19	but did not attach the proposed complaint. (ECF No. 3). The Court grants Plaintiff's motion	
20	for leave to file an amended complaint. Plaintiff shall file his amended complaint within 30	
21	days of the date of this order.

23	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that the motion for leave to file an	
24	amended complaint (ECF No. 3) is granted. Plaintiff shall file his amended complaint within	
25	30 days of the date of this order.
