

1 May 17, 2017, the Court granted Plaintiff a 45 day extension of time to serve. *See* ECF No. 65.
2 Plaintiff represents that he has made another ten (10) separate attempts at effectuating personal
3 service on Defendant. Further, Plaintiff performed searches of the county assessor's office and
4 phone directory. The Court finds that Plaintiff has provided sufficient good cause to warrant an
5 extension of time to serve Defendant Joseph Yakubik. Plaintiff also requests that he be permitted
6 to serve Defendant by publication. Plaintiff has demonstrated due diligence in attempting service
7 that would warrant permitting service by publication. Accordingly,

8 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** Plaintiff's Motion to Extend Time to Serve Defendant
9 Joseph Yakubi and, Alternatively, to Serve Defendant by Publication (ECF No. 68) is **granted** as
10 follows:

- 11 1. Defendant Joseph Yakubik may be served by Plaintiff through publication in this
12 case at least once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in the Nevada Legal News,
13 which is a newspaper of general circulation published in Las Vegas, Nevada. Said
14 service must be effectuated on or before **August 4, 2017**.
