**ORDER**

19 Defendant's Emergency Motion for Protective Order (Dkt. #16) came on for hearing on  
20 December 2, 2014, before Magistrate Judge George Foley, Jr. Defendant was represented by  
21 Michael K. Wall of the law firm Hutchison & Steffen, LLC, and Plaintiff was represented by  
22 Joseph Troiano of Marshall Law Office.

23 The Court, having reviewed the papers and pleadings submitted, including Defendant's  
24 Emergency Motion for Protective Order, Plaintiff's Opposition thereto, and Defendant's Reply  
25 brief, and having heard the oral arguments of counsel, finds and orders as follows:

26 IT IS ORDERED that Defendant's Emergency Motion for Protective Order (Dkt. #16) is  
27 granted.

28 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the videotaped depositions of American Family's

1 employees are limited solely for use in this case, and not for any other purpose, including any  
2 commercial use or distribution.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Plaintiff wants to use the videotaped depositions of  
4 American Family's employees for any purpose other than for use in this case, including but not  
5 limited to providing the depositions to someone else, Plaintiff must first petition this specific Court  
6 and delineate the need why Plaintiff wants to use the depositions outside the scope of this case.  
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8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court's Order granting Defendant's Emergency  
9 Motion for Protective Order (Dkt. #16) will survive beyond the existence of the instant case.  
10 Therefore, even after the resolution of this case, should Plaintiff want to use the videotaped  
11 depositions of American Family's employees for any use other than for use in this case, Plaintiff  
12 must first petition this Court for permission to use the depositions outside the scope of this case.  
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


