ORDER

Before the Court is Defendant Michael Belmonte's, a/k/a Michael Simmons's ("defendant"), Motion to File Electronically (doc. # 91), filed April 16, 2015.

In his motion, defendant asks permission to file, receive, and serve documents electronically in the instant case. See Doc. # 91. Defendant alleges he satisfies the requirements for filing electronically, including having an email account, the necessary hardware and software required to file electronically, and knowledge of the CM/ECF system. - a. On or before **Friday, April 24, 2015**, defendant shall provide certification that he has completed the CM/ECF tutorial and is familiar with Electronic Filing Procedures, Best Practices, and the Civil & Criminal Events Menu that are accessible on this Court's website,
