Pending before the Court is Defendant’s motion to withdraw certain exhibits from the record. Docket No. 87. On August 2, 2016, the Court granted Defendant’s motion for leave to file under seal. *See* Docket Nos. 64, 68. On August 12, 2016, Plaintiff filed a motion for reconsideration. Docket No. 71. Plaintiff contended that Defendant’s redactions did not meet the relevant sealing standards and that the order prejudiced Plaintiff. *See id.* at 7-20. Defendant responded to Plaintiff’s motion on August 29, 2016. Docket No. 74. Because Defendant was willing to revise its redactions, the Court ordered Defendant to file a renewed motion for leave to file under seal. Docket No. 76. Defendant then filed a renewed motion, Docket No. 77, which the Court denied for failure to include a memorandum of points and authorities. Docket No. 78. The Court ordered Defendant to file a renewed motion for leave to file under seal. *Id.* Defendant then filed a renewed motion that the Court denied for failure to properly address the sealing standards. Docket Nos. 79, 85.

Originally at issue were Exhibits E and G to a declaration by Christopher B. Hadley (Docket No. 62) that Defendant had filed in support of a motion to limit the number of patent claims asserted by Plaintiff (Docket No. 60). *See, e.g.,* Docket No. 71. Defendant now moves to withdraw all versions of these exhibits from the docket. *See* Docket No. 87.
