

1 regarding the lawyer's services and has been given reasonable warning that the lawyer will withdraw
2 unless the obligation is fulfilled." Here, based on Plaintiff's counsel's representation that Plaintiff has
3 failed to communicate with his counsel, the Court permits counsel to withdraw. LR IA 11-6(b); NRPC
4 1.16(b)(5). The Court finds that permitting counsel to withdraw would not result in delay. LR IA 11-6(e).

5 Accordingly, and for good cause shown,


6 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion to Withdraw as Counsel of Record for Christopher
7 Hunter (ECF No. 62) is GRANTED.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Yampolsky must mail a copy of this order to Plaintiff
9 Hunter and lodge Plaintiff's last known contact information with the court by April 3, 2018.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Hunter must either retain counsel or file a notice of
11 appearing pro se on or before May 4, 2018.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Hunter must file with the Court written notification of
13 any change of address.
