8	should be included in renewed motions, responses, and replies filed in compliance with the		
9	following schedule:		
10	• Schneider has until September 21, 2015, to file his renewed motion for partial		
11	summary judgment;		
12	• State Farm has until October 15, 2015, to file its response to that motion and its own		
13	renewed countermotion for summary judgment;		
14	• Schneider has until November 9, 2015, to file a reply in support of his renewed		
15	motion for partial summary judgment and his response to defendant's renewed		
16	countermotion;		
17	• State Farm has until November 28, 2015, to file its reply in support of its renewed		
18	countermotion.
