Rush Scott filed this action to seek review of the Social Security Commissioner's denial of his application for disability insurance benefits. Magistrate Judge Hoffman recommends that I deny Scott's motion for reversal or remand and grant the Commissioner's cross-motion to affirm.¹ Objections to the magistrate judge's recommendation were due May 20, 2016, and neither party has filed an objection or requested an extension to do so. "[N]o review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed."²
