

1 refused to exit the building to accept service, instead instructing the server to take the papers to
2 Caesar's Palace. Counsel for Caesar's Palace informed the process server that she is not authorized
3 to accept service for Defendant Brizuela. Subsequent phone calls to the Defendant have not been
4 answered and messages have not been returned. Nevada Rule of Civil Procedure 4(e)(1) permits
5 service by publication when the party to be served "by concealment seeks to avoid the service of
6 summons." Plaintiff has reasonably shown that Defendant Brizuela is actively avoiding service.
7 Accordingly,

8 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Motion to Extend Time to Serve Summons
9 and Complaint on Defendant Germann Brizuela and to Serve Defendant by Publication (#26) is
10 **granted.**

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff shall publish the summons and complaint at
12 least once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in
13 Clark County, Nevada. Plaintiff must also mail by U.S. Postal Service a copy of the summons and
14 complaint to Defendant Brizuela's last known residence pursuant to N.R.S. 4(e)(1)(iii). Service by
15 publication must be complete by **May 31, 2015.**
