This 13 14 constitutes consent to the granting of the motion under Local Rule 7-2(d), which states that "[t]he 15 failure of an opposing party to file points and authorities in response to any motion shall constitute 16 consent to the granting of the motion." Accordingly, and with good cause appearing, 17 It is HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant SelectHealth's Motion to Dismiss or Transfer 18 Venue and Supporting Memorandum of Points and Authorities [Doc. 34] is GRANTED as to the 19 request to dismiss and DENIED as to the alternate request to transfer venue. My Health, Inc.'s 20 claims [Doc. 1] are DISMISSED without prejudice. The Clerk of Court is instructed to close this 21 case. 22 Dated this 19th day of August, 2015 23 24 Jennifer A.
