ECF No. 116. He asserts default judgment should be entered because the defendants and their counsel 12 have engaged in unspecified misconduct. ECF No. 118. However, he does not identify what that 13 14 conduct is nor does he present any evidence in support. I therefore deny this motion. 15 Tagle also filed a motion for "punishment" of alleged "fraud." ECF No. 119 at 1. Tagle alleges that the defendants' counsel has engaged in unidentified dishonest behavior. Id. He also 16 17 asserts that the inmate library clerk forced him to sign documents without letting him look at them. Id. at 1-2. He further contends that he never requested help from the law librarian and that 18 19 he never filed a motion in this case. *Id.* at 2. He also references an email but does not explain 20 what email he is discussing. *Id.* Even if Tagle's allegations were comprehensible, he has 21 presented no evidence to support them. I therefore deny this motion. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff Victor Tagle's motion for default judgment 22 (ECF No. 118) is DENIED. 23 24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff Victor Tagle's motion for punishment of fraud (ECF No. 119) is DENIED. 25
