**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR  
SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

(ECF No. 139)

10 Plaintiff Victor Tagle moves for summary judgment. ECF No. 139. The motion fails for  
11 several reasons. Tagle does not offer any legal authority to support his request. Moreover, there  
12 are several genuine issues of material fact that preclude entry of summary judgment. Finally, in  
13 his reply, Tagle admits he is not requesting summary judgment, but rather seeks “default in favor  
14 of [himself] due to defendants’ criminal behavior.” ECF No. 156 at 3. That request, likewise,  
15 lacks any merit. I therefore deny Tagle’s motion.

16 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff Victor Tagle’s motion for summary  
17 judgment (**ECF No. 139**) is **DENIED**.
