(Docket No. 46)

16 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's motion to seal an exhibit to its motion for leave to file a  
17 second amended complaint. Docket No. 46. Plaintiff represents that the exhibit summarizes and quotes  
18 documents that Melaleuca, Inc., and Melaleuca of Canada, Inc., which are not parties to this case, have  
19 designated as confidential pursuant to a stipulated protective order in another case. Docket No. 46 at  
20 2. Plaintiff acknowledges that it must follow Ninth Circuit caselaw as to whether the exhibit should be  
21 seal, but explains that it has not yet had sufficient time to confer with procedures and requests additional  
22 time to confer with Melaleuca, Inc., and Melaleuca of Canada, Inc. regarding the applicable standards.  
23 *Id.* at 3.

24 Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Plaintiff shall **CONFER** with Melaleuca, Inc., and  
25 Melaleuca of Canada, Inc., no later than January 28, 2016, regarding the confidentiality designation of  
26 the subject document. To the extent a motion to seal remains necessary, no later than February 4, 2016,  
27 Plaintiff must file a supplement to its motion to seal with the appropriate declarations, which must  
28 address the proper standards for sealing in this Circuit. To the extent the parties do not believe that

1 sealing is necessary, Plaintiff shall so inform the Court and file the subject document on the public  
2 docket, no later than February 4, 2016.

3 IT IS SO ORDERED.
