10	Plaintiff US Bank Trust sued defendants Lessie Riggs-Smith and Raymond Smith for	
11	unlawful detainer in a Nevada state court. The Smiths filed a petition of removal invoking this	
12	court's civil-rights jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. §1443(1). US Bank timely moved to remand	
13	arguing that the Smiths cannot demonstrate jurisdiction based on section 1443, which is available	
14	only in very limited circumstances. ² The Smiths have not opposed US Bank's motion or requested	
15	an extension to file an opposition, and the deadline for doing so passed more than two months ago.	
16	Local Rule 7-2(d) provides, "[t]he failure of an opposing party to file points and authorities in	
17	response to any motion shall constitute a consent to the granting of the motion." As the Smiths have	
18	filed no opposition to US Bank's motion to remand, I deem their failure to oppose this motion a	
19	consent to remand. With good cause appearing and no reason to delay,	
20	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff's Motion to Remand [ECF 6] is GRANTED. This	
21	case is remanded back to the Justice Court, Clark County, Nevada; case number 15C001668.
