**ORDER REFERRING THIS CASE TO  
MAGISTRATE JUDGE FOLEY FOR  
TRIAL**

11           During the November 28, 2017 telephonic status check, the parties agreed that they would  
12 consent to a jury trial before a Magistrate Judge if the trial could be scheduled in January, 2018.  
13 Magistrate Judge George W. Foley is available to conduct a trial, with a firm setting, beginning on  
14 January 22, 2018. I have informed him that the parties are finalizing a stipulation to the admission  
15 of most of the medical-related exhibits (and possibly other exhibits as well), that the plaintiff  
16 anticipates calling 10-12 witnesses, that the defendant anticipates calling 4-5 additional witnesses,  
17 and that the trial will be completed in 5-6 days.

18           Judge Foley is willing to preside over the trial so long as the parties sign and submit the  
19 appropriate Consent to a Magistrate Judge form. *See* ECF No. 3. Once the fully-executed Consent  
20 form is submitted, Judge Foley will schedule a status check with the parties to discuss trial details.  
21 In the meantime, counsel for the respective parties will participate in the telephonic status check  
22 with me on **December 5, 2017 at 10:30 a.m.**
