14	This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Clerk to Sign Subpoenas	
15	(ECF No. 178), filed on September 7, 2017.	
16	Plaintiff represents that the Clerk's Office refused to issue subpoenas at Plaintiff's request	
17	because Plaintiff did not first obtain the Court's consent. Plaintiff argues that he is not required to	
18	obtain a court order prior to the issuance of the subpoenas because this is a civil case and LR 17-1(d)	
19	does not apply. The Court agrees. Plaintiff is appearing pro se and is not proceeding in this case in	
20	forma pauperis. Plaintiff, therefore, does not need to obtain the Court's approval for the issuance of	
21	subpoenas and he may obtain subpoenas in accordance with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.	
22	Nothing in this order is intended to otherwise validate any subpoena. Accordingly,	
23	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Clerk to Sign Subpoenas	
24	(ECF No. 178) is granted.
