Before the Court is Defendant Irma Mendez’s (“defendant”) Motion to File Electronically (doc. # 41), filed December 2, 2015.

In her motion, defendant asks to be allowed to engage in electronic case filings in this action. See Doc. # 41. Defendant alleges she satisfies the requirements for filing electronically, including having an email account, the necessary hardware and software required to file electronically, and knowledge of the CM/ECF system. 
