Ballard, on behalf of his client plaintiff J & J Sports Productions, 10Inc., tendered \$1,000 to the Clerk of Court for deposit into the court's Registry Account as security for costs required under NRS 18.130 and my order at ECF No. 20.¹ Once a bond is 11 12 posted under NRS 18.130(1), it "must remain for the defendant's benefit until the action is 13 dismissed or judgment is entered."² This action was eventually dismissed without prejudice due 14 to plaintiff's failure to prosecute, and no costs or charges were awarded against the plaintiff.³ 15 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is directed to disburse the full 16 bond amount and interest payable to "Bradley M.
