Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's motion for spoliation sanctions. Docket No. 87. On January 5, 2017, the Court referred this case to the *pro bono* pilot program and that process is still ongoing. *See* Docket No. 83. It is possible that a newly retained attorney may wish to amend the motion for sanctions or pursue another legal approach generally. As a result, the Court will hold the pending motion for spoliation sanctions in **ABEYANCE**. In the event that the motion remains pending (*i.e.*, it is not withdrawn or amended by a new appearing counsel), the response to the motion shall be filed by April 12, 2017. In the event *pro bono* counsel appears and does not withdraw or amend the motion, counsel shall file a joint stipulation as to a briefing schedule within 21 days of the appearance by *pro bono* counsel.
