 22 **(Second Request)**

23 THE PARTIES HEREBY STIPULATE, through their attorneys of record, to the
 24 following:

- 25 1. On April 20, 2017, the Court entered its Decision on Plaintiff's Motion
- 26 for Summary Judgment. The current deadline for the parties to submit the Joint
- 27 Pre-Trial Order is May 20, 2017.

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1 2. The parties Stipulated on May 18, 2017 to extend the time for the
2 filing of the Joint Pre-Trial Order because the parties anticipate that they may be
3 able to resolve this matter outside of litigation through action on the
4 administrative level. Specifically, Plaintiff's receipt of documentation may lead to
5 administrative action that may render this case moot.

7 3. Plaintiff's counsel was informed on **July 18, 2017** that the Texas
8 Department of Vital Statistics will be sending out Plaintiff's birth certificate.

9 4. Accordingly, the parties request that they have an additional 60
10 days, until September 20, 2017 to file their Joint Pre-Trial Order.

11 5. This is the second request for extension of time sought for this
12 specific purpose. The extension is sought in good faith and not for purposes of
13 delay.
