

1 argue that plaintiff was supplied with a compact disc containing video files of the incident, and
2 that defendant was provided supervised access to review the materials. (Response (ECF No. 80).)
3 Included with defendants' response is a declaration from the High Desert State Prison law library
4 supervisor, Jacques Graham. (ECF No. 80-5.) Graham's declaration states that the law library is
5 in possession of the disputed compact disc, and that library records indicate plaintiff reviewed the
6 materials on April 26, 2018, May 7, 2018, May 17, 2018 and May 21, 2018. (*Id.*) Given that
7 defendants have provided plaintiff with access to the recordings, the court will deny plaintiff's
8 motion to compel.

9 **III. MOTION TO EXTEND DISPOSITIVE MOTION DEADLINE**

10 Plaintiff moves for a 30-day extension of the dispositive motion deadline. (Mot. to
11 Extend (ECF No. 87).) Defendants do not oppose the request. The court will therefore extend
12 the dispositive motion deadline for 30 days.

13 **IV. CONCLUSION**

14 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff's motion to compel (ECF No. 79) is
15 DENIED.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's motion to extend the dispositive motion
17 deadline (ECF No. 87) is GRANTED. The parties have until September 10, 2018 to file
18 dispositive motions.
