Plaintiff Joyce 12 Jones objects, arguing that (1) "[f]ederal [c]ourts can decide any case that considers federal law," 13 14 (2) the defendants breached a contract with her, and (3) she files suit under a California statute. 15 (Dkt. #3.) I conducted a de novo review of the issues set forth in the Report & Recommendation. 28 16 17 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Judge Ferenbach set forth the proper legal analysis and factual basis for the decision. 18 19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the report and recommendation (Dkt. #2) is 20 accepted. 21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this action is DISMISSED for lack of subject matter 22 jurisdiction.
