13	with prejudice because these individual defendants are not proper targets for ADA claims. ¹ "[N]o	
14	review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed." ²	
15	Objections to the magistrate judge's report and recommendation were due by March 30, 2017, and	
16	no objections have been filed. Accordingly,	
17	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the magistrate judge's report and recommendation [ECF	
18	No. 10] is ADOPTED. All claims against Doug Parker, Steve Olson, and Ron Rhoderick are	
19	DISMISSED with prejudice.
