Espiritu lost 12 that appeal,<sup>2</sup> and defendant Pintar Investment Company Residential, LP now moves to release the 13 supersedeas bond to its counsel's trust account.<sup>3</sup> Espiritu agrees to the release.<sup>4</sup> 14 Accordingly, with good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pintar's Motion to 15 Release Supersedeas Bond [ECF No. 136] is GRANTED. The Clerk of Court is directed to 16 release and pay the \$38,000 in cash posted in this action [ECF No. 126] to "The Law Offices of 17 P.
