No. 179 at 1–2). The parties have made considerable progress in performing the settlement

agreement. (Id. at 2). The BLM has worked "to process the request for the sale of the parcels and has been conducting its due diligence" but has been impeded by the coronavirus shutdown. (Id.). Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that this action shall remain administratively stayed until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 8, 2021, pending the parties' performance of the settlement agreement. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if the settlement is not fully performed, the parties shall file a motion requesting a continuance of the administrative stay and explaining the status of the sale before 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 8, 2021. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file a motion to lift the stay and a notice of dismissal within 14 days of performance of the settlement agreement. DATED September 10, 2020.
