ORDER


This matter is before the Court on Defendant Roundpoint Mortgage’s Notice of Disassociation and Wtihdrawal of Counsel (ECF No. 84), filed on February 24, 2017.

Counsel for Defendant represents that Christopher S. Connell, Esq. is no longer associated with the law firm of Wright, Finlay & Zak, LLP.
