As plaintiff is still represented by counsel, the withdrawal will cause 19 no delay in this matter. 20 Having reviewed and considered the matter, and for good cause shown, 21 **IT IS ORDERED** that: 22 1. Cal J. Potter, III and Cal J. Potter, IV's Motion to Withdraw (ECF No. 65) as pro hac 23 vice counsel is **GRANTED**. 24 2. Attorney Ralph M.
