**STIPULATION AND ORDER TO

1 **A. Introduction**

2 Plaintiff is a first party claimant for underinsured motorist benefits under a policy of
3 insurance with Defendant GEICO Casualty Insurance Company

4 **B. Reason for Extension**

5 The parties believe that a seven (7) day extension of the deadline to file a reply is necessary
6 and appropriate to provide sufficient time to complete an adequate reply. Defendant’s counsel
7 requested the extension since she was traveling for business the week prior and due to various
8 factors, the travel adversely interfered with Defendant’s opportunity to complete Defendant’s
9 reply in support of its motion for summary judgment. The parties believe that good cause is
10 demonstrated and both agreed to a seven (7) day extension of the deadline to respond.
