(ECF No. 24). In that Order, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's claims for breach of 13 14 15

fiduciary duty and unfair labor practices without prejudice. (Id. 11:17–18). Plaintiff was given until April 17, 2017, to file an amended complaint that sufficiently stated these claims and was warned that failure to file an amended complaint by that date would result in those claims being dismissed with prejudice. As of the date of this Order, however, Plaintiff has failed to file an amended complaint.
