ORDER

Pending before the Court is the Report and Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge George W. Foley, Jr., (ECF No. 21), which recommends that Plaintiff Robyn J. Williams’ Motion for Reversal or Remand, (ECF No. 13), be granted and the Commissioner’s Cross-Motion to Affirm, (ECF No. 18), be denied.

A party may file specific written objections to the findings and recommendations of a United States Magistrate Judge made pursuant to Local Rule IB 1-4. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B); D. Nev. R. IB 3-2. Upon the filing of such objections, the Court must make a de novo determination of those portions to which objections are made. *Id.* The Court may accept, reject, or modify, in whole or in part, the findings or recommendations made by the Magistrate Judge. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); D. Nev. IB 3-2(b). Where a party fails to object, however, the Court is not required to conduct “any review at all . . . of any issue that is not the subject of an objection.” *Thomas v. Arn*, 474 U.S. 140, 149 (1985). Indeed, the Ninth Circuit has recognized that a district court is not required to review a magistrate judge’s report and recommendation where no objections have been filed. See, e.g., *United States v. Reyna–Tapia*, 328 F.3d 1114, 1122 (9th Cir. 2003).

4 **ACCEPTED and ADOPTED** in full.


5 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff Robyn J. Williams' Motion for Reversal or
