 20 **PLAINTIFF’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR**  
 21 **EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO DEFENDANT’S**  
 22 **MOTION TO DISMISS PLAINTIFF’S COMPLAINT**

23 **(THIRD REQUEST)**

24 Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure (“FRCP”) 6(b)(1)(A), Plaintiff respectfully  
 25 requests that the Court extend by six business days, or until October 10, 2016, the time within  
 26 which Plaintiff must respond to Defendant’s motion to dismiss Plaintiff’s Complaint. Presently,

1 Plaintiff's response is due on September 30, 2016. This is Plaintiff's third request for an  
2 extension of time for the purpose set forth herein. Counsel for the United States, Katherine Foss,  
3 Esq., has kindly indicated she has no opposition to this request.

4 In support of this motion, Plaintiff relies upon the memorandum of points and authorities  
5 set forth below.

6 **MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES**

7 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 6(b)(1)(A) permits a party to extend a deadline prior to  
8 its expiration upon a showing of "good cause." The standard to be applied by a court under  
9 FRCP 6(b)(1) is a liberal one in order to "effectuate the general purpose of seeing that cases are  
10 tried on the merits." Ahanchian v. Xenon Pictures, Inc., 624 F.3d 1253, 1258-59 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2010).  
11 "Good cause is a non-rigorous standard that has been construed broadly across procedural and  
12 statutory contexts." Id at 1259.

13 Here, undersigned counsel's work schedule requires a short extension of time to file a  
14 response to the pending dispositive motion. Although undersigned counsel has been working to  
15 complete a response, and has nearly done so, an additional six business days will permit him  
16 sufficient time to complete, review and finalize an appropriate response to the pending  
17 dispositive motion while at the same time balancing other case commitments.<sup>1</sup> While  
18 undersigned counsel has co-counsel that will assist in finalizing the response, co-counsel are  
19 exceptionally busy during the coming week with a filing due in the United States Court of  
20 Appeals for the Ninth Circuit and will not be able to assist until the end of next week.

21 With respect to competing case commitments, undersigned counsel is himself extremely  
22 busy in the next three days with discovering closing in a significant civil case pending in state

1 court. In that case, defendants have filed several motions that will need to be responded to and  
2 undersigned counsel anticipates devoting the next two business days to completing those  
3 responses. During the past three days, undersigned counsel was not able to devote sufficient time  
4 to this case as he was required to respond to thirteen motions *in limine* filed in yet another state  
5 case with a trial scheduled to commence on October 10, 2016. A short extension of time,  
6 however, will permit undersigned counsel sufficient time to complete and file a response to the  
7 pending dispositive motion.

8 **CONCLUSION**

9 Based upon the foregoing, undersigned counsel respectfully requests that the Court grant  
10 this motion.
