12	Before the court is the parties' Stipulation and Order to Extend Scheduled Deadlines (First
13	Request) (ECF No. 24). The court recently granted leave to file a third-party complaint. The
14	parties are requesting a 150-day extension of the discovery plan and scheduling order deadlines
15	measured from the appearance of the last third-party defendant. The court agrees an adjustment
16	of the discovery plan and scheduling order deadlines will be required and that it would waste
17	resources to conduct certain discovery which may need to be duplicated once the third parties have
