Banks did not comply with that order or request an extension to do so, so the magistrate judge now recommends 13 that I dismiss this case without prejudice.² "[N]o review is required of a magistrate judge's report 14 and recommendation unless objections are filed." Objections to the magistrate judge's report and 15 16 recommendation were due by September 9, 2016, and Banks has not filed an objection or requested 17 an extension to do so. Accordingly, 18 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the magistrate judge's report and recommendation 19 [ECF No. 4] is ADOPTED, and this case is DISMISSED without prejudice. 20 The Clerk of Court is directed to CLOSE THIS CASE. 21
