**(First Request)**

The parties through their respective counsel hereby stipulate to extend the time for filing of parties' Opposition to Defendant Kiewit Western Co.'s Motion for Summary Judgment [ECF No. 89], from October 8, 2019 to December 4, 2019, and the filing of Defendant's Reply brief in support of its Motion for Summary Judgment to December 18, 2019. This is the parties' first request for an extension of time.

Defendant Kiewit's Motion for Summary Judgment was filed on September 17, 2019, with the deadline for the parties' Opposition being October 8, 2019. Good cause exists for the requested extension because discovery is still ongoing. On October 3, 2019, the parties submitted

1 a Stipulation and Order to Extend Discovery for 60 days, which was granted. The deposition of  
2 Defendant Kiewit Western Co.'s FRCP 30(b)(6) designee is currently scheduled to take place on  
3 November 4, 2019. This testimony is necessary for the parties to adequately respond to Defendant  
4 Kiewit's Motion for Summary Judgment. As discovery is still ongoing, Plaintiffs have requested  
5 additional time to respond to Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment. Defendant will in turn  
6 require additional time to prepare a reply in support of Defendant's Motion.

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Accordingly, good cause exists to extend the briefing deadlines for both parties as follows:

- December 4, 2019: Deadline for Oppositions to Defendant Kiewit's Motion for Summary Judgment.
- December 18, 2019: Deadline for Defendant Kiewit's Reply brief in support of its Motion for Summary Judgment.


