The stipulation requests to extend the dispositive motion 14 deadline from November 13, 2017, until 30 days after ruling on the Motion for Judgment on the 15 Pleadings (ECF No. 66) and the Motion for Partial Summary Judgment (ECF No. 76). Having 16 reviewed and considered the parties' stipulation, the court finds the parties have not established 17 good cause to delay filing dispositive motions until after decision of the pending motions. 18 Discovery has now closed. The parties now have a fully developed record, and have received two 19 prior extensions of the dispositive motions deadline.
