Judge Koppe warned Grabowski that if she failed to file the court-ordered motion by July 14, 2017, Judge Koppe 12 would recommend that this case be dismissed.<sup>2</sup> On December 22, 2017, Grabowski still had not 13 filed a motion to reverse or remand, so Judge Koppe issued the forewarned recommendation.<sup>3</sup> 14 Grabowski had until January 5, 2018, to object or otherwise respond to Judge Koppe's 15 16 recommendation, but she failed in that regard, too. 17 "[N]o review is required of a magistrate judge's report and recommendation unless objections are filed."
