P. 16(c)(9) (emphasis 8 added.) 9 In this case, a seven-member Board of County Commissioners for Clark County has 10 the ultimate authority to settle the case. However, this Defendant requests exception from 11 attendance by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to LR 16-6(e).
