ORDER

MOTION FOR JURY TRIAL (ECF No.23)

9 Before the Court is Plaintiff Lee White's Motion for Jury Trial (ECF 23). For the reasons stated
10 below, Plaintiff's motion is denied.

11 In his motion, Plaintiff lists the basis for his claims and requests a judgment granting Plaintiff
12 (1) compensatory damages, (2) punitive damages, (3) a jury trial, and (4) costs. (ECR 23 at 1-3). This
13 motion was filed two days before Defendants filed an answer to Plaintiff's complaint. (ECF 24). At this
14 stage of the proceedings, any order granting judgment in Plaintiff's favor or setting a trial date would be
15 premature.¹

17 ACCORDINGLY, and for good cause shown,

18 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion (ECF 23) is DENIED.
