| 14 | According to the Clark County Detention Center ("CCDC") inmate database, Plaintiff |
| 15 | is no longer incarcerated. However, Plaintiff has not filed an updated address with this Court. |
| 16 | The Court notes that pursuant to Nevada Local Special Rule 2-2, "[t]he plaintiff must |
| 17 | immediately file with the court written notification of any change of address. The notification |
| 18 | must include proof of service on each opposing party or the party's attorney. Failure to comply |
| 19 | with this rule may result in dismissal of the action with prejudice." Nev. Loc. Special R. 2-2. |
| 20 | This Court grants Plaintiff thirty (30) days from the date of entry of this order to file his updated |
| 21 | address with this Court. If Plaintiff does not update the Court with his current address within |
| 22 | thirty (30) days from the date of entry of this order, the Court will dismiss this action without |
| 23 | prejudice. |
| 24 | II. CONCLUSION |
| 25 | For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file his updated address |
| 26 | with the Court within thirty (30) days from the date of this order. |
