



1           2.       The movant herein is permitted to maintain this action to conclusion without the  
2 necessity of prepayment of any additional fees or costs or the giving of security therefor. This  
3 order granting leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* shall not extend to the issuance and/or  
4 service of subpoenas at government expense.

5           3.       Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2), the Nevada Department of Corrections shall  
6 pay to the Clerk of the United States District Court, District of Nevada, 20% of the preceding  
7 month's deposits to Plaintiff's account (**Lionell Jackson, #24069**), in the months that the  
8 account exceeds \$10.00, until the full \$350.00 filing fee has been paid for this action. The  
9 Clerk of the Court shall **SEND** a copy of this order to the Finance Division of the Clerk's Office.  
10 The Clerk of the Court shall also **SEND** a copy of this order to the attention of the Chief of  
11 Inmate Services for the Nevada Department of Corrections, P.O. Box 7011, Carson City, NV  
12 89702.

13           4.       The Clerk of the Court shall electronically **SERVE** a copy of this order and a copy  
14 of Plaintiff's complaint (ECF No. 11) on the Office of the Attorney General of the State of  
15 Nevada by adding the Attorney General of the State of Nevada to the docket sheet. This does  
16 not indicate acceptance of service.

17           5.       Service must be perfected within ninety (90) days from the date of this order  
18 pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m).

19           6.       Subject to the findings of the screening order (ECF No. 10), within **twenty-one**  
20 **(21) days** of the date of entry of this order, the Attorney General's Office shall file a notice  
21 advising the Court and Plaintiff of: (a) the names of the defendants for whom it accepts  
22 service; (b) the names of the defendants for whom it does not accept service, and (c) the  
23 names of the defendants for whom it is filing the last-known-address information under seal.  
24 As to any of the named defendants for whom the Attorney General's Office cannot accept  
25 service, the Office shall file, *under seal*, but shall not serve the inmate Plaintiff the last known  
26 address(es) of those defendant(s) for whom it has such information. If the last known address  
27 of the defendant(s) is a post office box, the Attorney General's Office shall attempt to obtain  
28 and provide the last known physical address(es).
